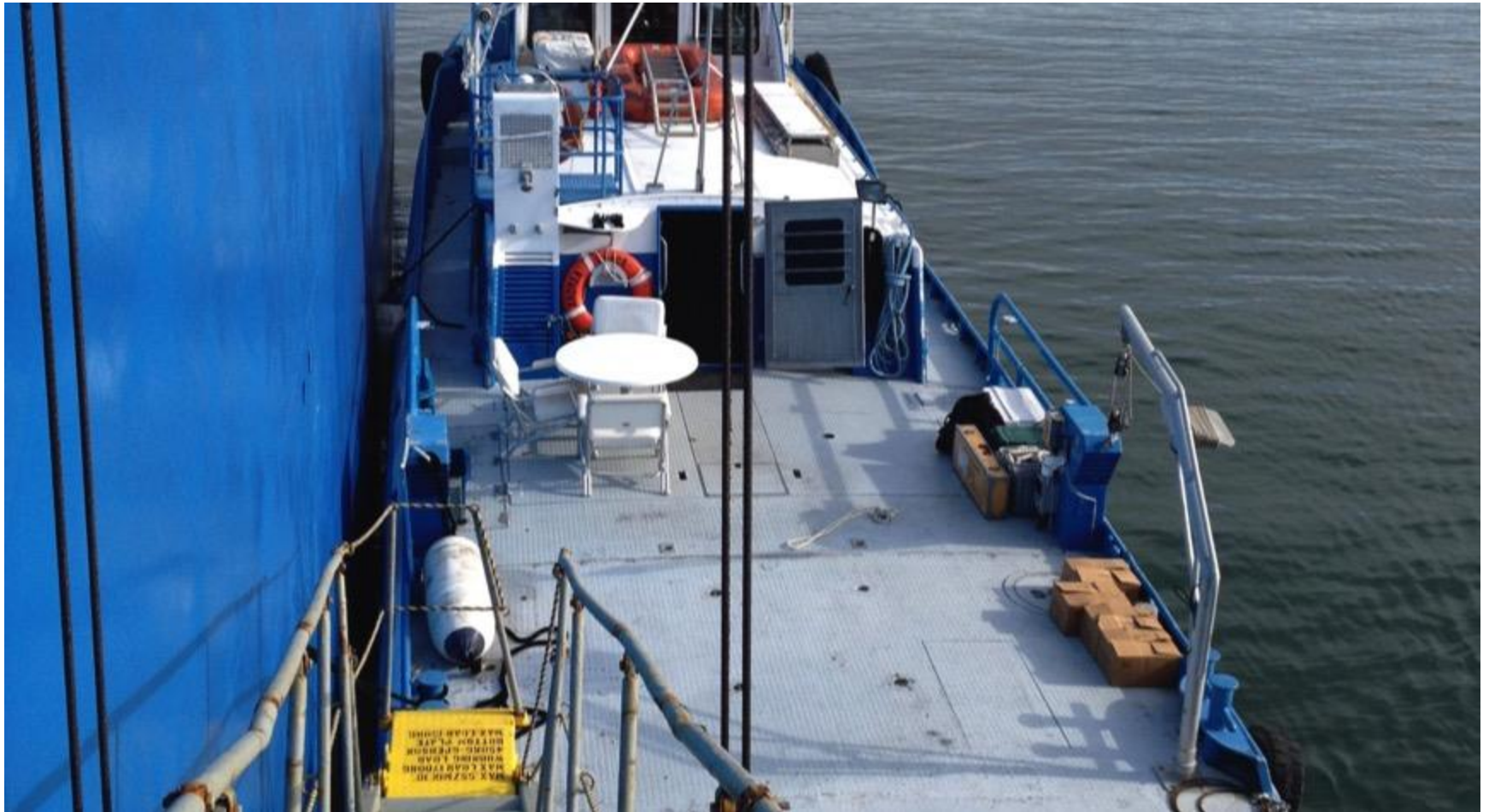

PRE-TRIP

All vessels operating systems, machinery, bilges pumps mechanical, electrical and safety systems are checked weekly and prior to departure.

Back-up starters, alternators, raw water pumps, navigation aids etc. are stored on board.
